

## OEA – Leaderboard Policy

The OEA maintains a separate leaderboard for the Regular EC Divisions and the U25 Divisions.

OEA Membership	OEA membership is required for all riders who wish to accumulate points on the leaderboards.

FEI Placings	Double points to be awarded for riders who place in FEI Divisions for the corresponding EC level: 1* - EV105; 2* - EV110; 3* - EV115; 4* - EV120
Combined Divisions	Combined divisions may be offered at Horse Trials at the discretion of Organizers. These divisions will have the dressage and jumping tests at one level higher than the cross-country test. Points for placings in combined divisions (e.g. EV100/EV110) will be attributed to the lower level (e.g. EV100) consistent with the level of the cross-country test (EC regulation D301.3).

*Note: Starters are all those competitors that start the competition by entering the competition dressage arena. Eliminations and withdrawals/retirements are considered starters.*

### OEA Leaderboard General Disbursement Rules

- For all divisions, if there are fewer than 10 riders in total in any 2 or more categories (Open/Senior/Junior), the leaderboards for those categories will be combined into one leaderboard. The final combination of categories in each division will be assessed at the end of the season for the purposes of Year-End placings.
- Open Category vs Regular (Jr/Sr) Category? If a horse and rider combination has completed three (3) or more events meeting MER requirements in a particular division and then drops down to a lower division, they must compete as ‘Open’. If, upon reviewing the leaderboards, a rider feels they are not in the correct category, please email [info@ontarioeventing.ca](mailto:info@ontarioeventing.ca) to have it reviewed.
- If organisers combine the Open/Senior/Junior categories, points will be awarded in the appropriate category based on the total # of starters in the division which combined the categories.
- Ties will be broken for year-end awards for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place using the following methodology:
  - In the event of a tie, whichever combination has more total points from ONLY their top 6 placings during the season will place higher.
  - If still tied, the combination with the most 1<sup>st</sup> places finishes will break the tie.
- **U25 Leaderboard:** Points are calculated and awarded as per the Calculation of Year-End Points table (above). In addition to all other possible points, an extra 10 points will be awarded to U25 riders for the NAYC or FEI competitions, even where they are held outside the province of Ontario.
  - ***For the U25 Leaderboards ONLY - if a rider places in two divisions, prize money is awarded in the higher level only.***
